**This schedule provides all the information you need to make the most of your week's holiday with your dogs. It also includes all the rules and guidelines covering the week, which must be strictly adhered to so to make the most of a good time we suggest you read through it.**

**Security: ID bracelets will be issued on arrival Which Must Be Worn All Week  
Vehicle & Camping passes will be issued on arrival. These Must Be Displayed All Week**

These are for your safety and security. Replacement bands will be available from the Secretary.

If you've got DOGS or CHILDREN then this bit's for you – which means it's for everybody.

Rule 52: People or dogs acting in an unreasonable/irresponsible manner will be removed from the show and forfeit all fees paid.

**All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult who will be held responsible for their conduct for the duration of the show.**

No more than 2 dogs per handler off lead in the showground exercise area. PLEASE CLEAR UP after your dogs and place in the bins provided **on the showground**. If you knowingly don't, we will tell you to leave - it's as simple as that. So BAG IT & BIN IT!! The Woods & Common are CLEAR UP areas please **BAG IT & BIN IT** in the bins provided **on the showground**.

Please don't bring training equipment with you because we will not let you use it and you'll have carted all that weight around with you for nothing. Much better to use the space for another couple of bottles.

If you have children with you then they are your responsibility, and are assumed to be under your supervision at all times. Yes – even if they're 6ft tall and tower over you! This means you always know where they are and what they are doing. And if what they are doing is anti-social then we may ask you to leave. We may sympathise, but we don't condone. Parents, please advise your children on safety measures on site, with particular emphasis on road safety and bikes.

Remember the 5mph speed limit doesn't just refer to 4 wheels but 2 wheels as well (and anything else you can find to move about on)

**This is a working showground (not a bowling green) consequently the ground cannot be guaranteed to be totally flat, there are dips and hollows, some maybe created by your own dogs. Please be careful and observant. If you see uneven ground that could be a hazard either bring it to the attention of the show manager or avail yourself of the pile of earth adjacent to ring 4 under the trees, which is there for the purpose of filling holes.**

**For some of the activities at this show we may require you to sign a disclaimer. If you are unable to do this then we are sorry but you will not be able to participate.**

And of course - THE RULES - you do of course read them avidly on every schedule you receive, but could we ask you to read **Rules 41** onwards again, just to make sure. These are particularly pertinent to the Dogs in Need show. All of the pages in this schedule relate to Rules and Regulations and must be adhered to. So this is a rule to read the Rules!

Due to restrictions placed on us by the local council there will be a reduced PA area, but for all your information and announcements Radio Dogs In Need will be broadcasting again this year, wavelength will be near to last years 86.6 FM and will be confirmed at the show. This will be during show hours for general announcements and 24 hours a day for emergencies. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licenced event should take all reasonable steps to ensure that the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations

**Warning: Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.**

**Dogs In Need is a Private event only open to Competitors & guests at DINAS discretion.  
It is not open to the general public.**



## WHAT CAN I ENTER?

**YOUR DOG MAY ENTER ANY 3 INDIVIDUAL CLASSES PER DAY FOR WHICH YOUR DOG IS ELIGIBLE PLUS, ANY ELIGIBLE HELPING HANDS & YKC CLASSES**

That's basically it. Your dog can only enter a **YKC** class providing the handler is a member of the YKC. Your dog can only enter **Helping Hands** if the handler does not run in any other class all week but helps at the show. Please note, the **Junior Classic** classes are included within the three-run limit, they are NOT extra classes.

## WHAT CAN'T I ENTER?

Just as easy -

**NOT MORE THAN 3 INDIVIDUAL CLASSES PER DAY FOR WHICH YOUR DOG IS ELIGIBLE!**  
**(with the exception of the above exceptions!)**

Now **everyone** has the same number of runs - how's that for fairness? As usual a dog may only be eligible for, and therefore gain points towards, one **Classic Final** - although they could enter classes for different **Classic** heats (e.g. an ABC jumping and a Graded Jumping) – Please select which Classic you want to earn points for when entering online. Full Classic rules can be found on page 6.

## WHAT DO I GET IF I'M BRILLIANT?

With the exception of the Any Size classes (see page 12) we will be awarding:-

**Trophies** to 1<sup>st</sup> place in all classes, to second place if entries reach more than 30 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place for more than 50.  
**Rosettes** to 10% in all classes. Clear Round Rosettes in all standard classes which must be collected at the ring as soon as you have got the necessary clear round. (Please also see rule 53)

And the really clever clogs get the chance to compete in: **THE WEEK'S FINALS**, where you can win:

Trophies 1st – 3<sup>rd</sup> for all Grades/Finals  
Rosettes: 1st – 3<sup>rd</sup> + Finalists Rosettes

## Camping, Electric Hook Up & Safety

Camping pitches are 10m x 6m, which you can fence in, if you erect a tent within that pitch there must be at least a 3m gap between it and the main unit. You can park your vehicle to the side but you may not fence that in as it is a fire break as designated by the local fire authority.

### **Roadways to be kept clear AT ALL TIMES.**

Each pitch is for one camping unit only, please ensure you book enough pitches to accommodate your set-up.

**Remember to tell us who you want to camp with and remember to tell the rest of your camping group to use the same name. People camping in groups who require electric will be sited nearest to the electric supply points. Camping location will be advised on check in – not before. On arrival, please display your Identification Number in your window to speed up booking in.**

Electric hook-up can only be supplied if pre-paid, and is 240v 6-amp rate maximum supply only. It is your responsibility to provide a cable that is long enough to plug into the supply (minimum 25 metres). **IT WILL REQUIRE A BLUE 3 PIN MALE CEE PLUG (CARAVAN TYPE) ON THE END.**

We strongly recommend that before arriving at the show you have your caravan electrics tested as most of the problems with electrics are caused by faulty caravan electrics.

We will have an electrician on site between the hours of 6:30-8:00 am and 5:00-6:30 pm and on call 8:00 am – 5:00 pm to reinstate electric trips only NOT to repair caravan faults. We cannot re-instate electrics outside of these hours.

Camping will be limited and everyone will initially be put on a waiting list, so don't panic that you haven't got a camping spot straight away. Confirmation will be sent by email when/if you get a pitch, before the closing date for entries.

**All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult who will be held responsible for their conduct for the duration of the show.**

**All camping units MUST vacate the site by 3:00pm Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025.**

Fire points at the show will be denoted by a Red Flag, please **DO NOT** fly a red flag at the show. All units to have means of extinguishing a fire available.

**BBQ's – No disposable or ground BBQ's.**

**Generators – Only suitcase type/completely enclosed generators are permitted.**

**NB For those using generators if we get a complaint, you will be required to turn it off for the week.**

(a) For the safety of dogs/people it is the responsibility of those using electric hook-ups and/or generators to provide adequate protection for cables and their own lead. People camping in groups who require electric will be sited nearest to the electric supply points.

(b) No camping units allowed on the Show ground before 9.00am Monday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2025. Early show helpers will be notified by a committee member and must book in on arrival. Camping numbers are limited. The Show ground will be locked from 23.00hrs - 07.00 hrs each night. Camping units will be received Monday 11<sup>th</sup> – Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 9.00am – 5.00pm only and all MUST vacate showground by 3:00 pm Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025.

(c) Camping pitches and electric hook-ups are **NOT TRANSFERABLE** and may not be purchased after close of entries. All units MUST display the official site pass on their unit denoting camping & or electric hook up. Anyone found accessing camping and or electric hook-up without the appropriate site pass will be removed from the showground.

(d) All camping roadways on site must be kept clear at all times. The erection of training equipment is forbidden.

**Speed limit on site is 5mph (KC recommendation) and will be strictly enforced. All drivers of vehicles on site must hold a full driving licence and be insured.**

# THE DINAS CLASSICS

## PLEASE READ THE RULES CAREFULLY!

- 1 The **DINAS Classics** will be in thirty-two categories. Each Classic will have four qualifying classes, 2 agility and 2 jumping, for which points may be gained to qualify towards the Invitation Final.
- 2 **Dogs** may enter a maximum of three Classic classes per day for which they are eligible, but may only qualify for one Final which must be nominated on your entries. If no Final has been nominated, and it is not clear which Final applies, then the Final may be assumed by us.
- 3 Points will be awarded to non-eliminated dogs in each class of the nominated or assumed Classic in the following manner - 1st place will receive 50 points, 2nd place 49 points, etc. down to 1 point to the last non-eliminated dog.
- 4 The main handler on the entry form will be the handler listed in the posted league tables, and will be the handler invited to compete in the Finals. If a change of handler is required, the main handler must notify Agilityplaza **in writing** as soon as possible after the qualifiers have been declared but no later than 9.00am on the morning of the event.
- 5 A full listing of dog/handler combinations achieving points will be updated and available to view on Agility Plaza when each qualifying heat closes. Those appearing in the final listing up to and including the designated lowest place will be invited to take part in the Finals on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> or Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- 6 Invited finalists must book in on the morning of the relevant Final at the Ring 1 score tent by the designated time as detailed below. Booking in is achieved by completing and handing in a commentary card, which can be collected from Agility Plaza from the night before the Final. Late entries will not be accepted. You may get someone to book in on your behalf.
- 7 A list of invited Finalists will be displayed at the Show the evening of the last Classic heats for that Classic.
- 8 The number to qualify in each final will be decided on completion of the four qualifying classes, and will be displayed at the Show.
- 9 The dog/handler running order for each final will be displayed at the ring and will be strictly adhered to.
- 10 There will be **NO** reserves called for the final.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licenced Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted).

Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping Classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: A Ramp, Dog Walk and See-Saw. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

A maximum of four standard classes may be scheduled for any dog on an individual day of competition. Any number of special classes may be scheduled.

**Class Structure.** A class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded class may be scheduled for a maximum of three consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

A class will be won by the dog that has completed the course in the fastest time with the least number of faults, unless stated otherwise for special classes.

**Progression.** Progression from each Grade will be determined by the eligibility for the class as referenced in H(1)(A)11. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade. To count for progression wins must be gained in standard classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows. Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at Small, Medium, Intermediate or Large height without their dog(s) before the class begins.

**Points Progression.** At the handlers discretion the dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.d refers). A minimum of 50 points must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes in the relevant grade. except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

Progression on points must be done prior to closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

## STANDARD CLASSES.

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licenced Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the two wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

**Grade 1** Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 1 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

**Grade 2** Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1 and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 3** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 4** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 5** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 6 or 7.

**Grade 6** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained at Agility (not Jumping) Classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

**Grade 7** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

**Championship Class** Open to dogs having qualified to compete in Grade 7 which have had five wins at Full Height in either Grade 6 or Grade 7, at least three of which must be gained in agility classes. To consist of 2 qualifying rounds of Standard Kennel Club Classes, 1 Agility Class and 1 Jumping Class and a final round of Agility to be held at the same Show.

## SPECIAL CLASSES

Societies may schedule classes other than those defined above as “special classes”. The eligibility for “special” classes must be defined by the society and included in the schedule. The word “special” must be included in the title of the class. Where special classes are classified for older and/or inexperienced dogs, the height of the hurdles, the A-ramp, and the dog walk, and the length of the long jump, may be reduced below the dimensions specified in these regulations, in which case such dimensions must be included in the class definition in the show schedule.

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes, but must be specified in the schedule. Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows.

**CLASSIC-JUNIOR UNDER 12 YRS:** Open to handlers under 12 years of age as at 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025

**CLASSIC-JUNIOR 12-15 YRS:** Open to handlers aged 12 or over but under 16 years of age as at 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025.

**YKC JUNIOR 6 – 11 YRS:** Open to handlers 6 years and up to but not including 12<sup>th</sup> birthday

**YKC JUNIOR 12 – 14 YRS:** Open to handlers 12 years and up to but not including 15<sup>th</sup> birthday

**YKC JUNIOR 15 – 17 YRS:** Open to handlers 15 years and up to but not including 18<sup>th</sup> birthday

**YKC JUNIOR 18 – 24 YRS:** Open to handlers 18 years and up to but not including 25<sup>th</sup> birthday

Please check Junior eligibility carefully for all Junior classes at the show.

**ABC:** This class is open to all Large and Intermediate dogs excluding Border Collies, Working Sheepdogs and their crosses. (Any breeds but collies). In the event of a dispute the judges decision will be final.

**ANY SIZE:** These classes are for dogs not entered in any other class at this show except Any Size. They are fun classes aimed at those dogs either nearing retirement but still fit or just setting out on their agility career. There will be no Weaving Poles, Tyre or Long Jump. Jump heights will be 400mm, 300mm & 200mm and you may run your dog at whichever height you wish regardless of their size. The course will be simple and free flowing with a maximum of 18 obstacles. There will be no place rosettes or trophies but special clear round rosettes will be awarded.

**Overseas visitors please note, you MUST have your ATC number from the British Kennel Club BEFORE you can enter the show, and this number MUST be recorded on your entry.**

**A dog may only compete at the height and grade for which they are eligible.**

**Helping Hands** – This class will be a Free of Charge invitation jumping event on Saturday, for all sizes and all grades (so borrow a good un). Handlers must not have run a dog in any other class during the week and, of course, must have helped at the show during the week. This class is for those noble helpers who do the work without running a dog. If it was just for anyone who helps then it would have about 2000 dogs in it! (We hope!). For your invitation to run see the Show Manager or Show Secretary. Maximum 2 dogs per handler.

## **Dogs In Vehicles**

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts of travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free-flowing air around the dog.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

## SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility shows must be registered at the Royal Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/authority to compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club authority to compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club registration number or an authority to compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Entry Fees: Standard Class £5.50, Crufts Qualifiers £6.50 (Intermediate & Large ABC, Small & Medium Novice Cup - £1.00 of this fee goes to The Kennel Club) YKC ADOTY £10.00, Championship £20.00, Any Size £3.00, Camping £125.00, Electric Hook-Up £80.00, Non Camping Facilities Charge £2.00 per household per day.
4. No prize money will be paid.
5. Internet entries only will be accepted via Agility Plaza.
6. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of the competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed agility shows.
8. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
9. Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 12 weeks and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
10. A bitch which is in season is allowed to attend the show providing it is kept away from the competition areas. Except those dogs that are attending the show to compete in quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals of Royal Kennel Club Prestige Events, other than those events held under YKC rules, who are allowed to compete in these classes only. Qualified handlers are asked to remove their dog from the competition area as soon as they have competed in the Prestige Event.
11. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competition is forbidden.
12. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
13. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
14. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
15. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
16. Sponsors are listed on page 14.
17. Detailed rules for Crufts Qualifiers can be accessed on page 13.
18. Kennel Club standard marking regulations apply for all standard classes.
19. Jump heights for Any Size will be 200mm, 300mm & 400mm (See page 12)
20. The height limit for dogs.
  - a. Large dog classes-For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers.
  - b. Intermediate dog classes. For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers.
  - c. Medium dog classes. For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers.
  - d. Small dog classes. For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.
21. Judges at an agility show may not judge a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
22. Removal of dogs from competition:

Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the show if it is:-

  - 1 Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - 2 Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - 3 Of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - 4 Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show incident book and submitted to the Royal Kennel Club.
23. Removal of competitors.

No equipment shall be moved without permission of the judge. Any concerns regarding the course shall be discussed with the judge/show management. Any unauthorised movement of equipment may result in the removal of the competitor from the show. All such removals should be reported to The Royal Kennel Club in the incident book.

- 24 Dog agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in agility classes on the day of the show.
- 25 In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition, i.e. 18<sup>th</sup> July 2025, shall be counted when entering for any class. For those purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitors responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
- 26 Should circumstances so dictate the society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to The Royal Kennel Club.
- 27 In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less any reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event, the society will refund fees within three months of the show date to all those that had entered and requested a refund within one month of the show date and on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope.
- 28 Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be carried in the hand or given to the dog whilst in the ring. Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.
- 29 No dogs' crates or boxes should left near or between the rings. Societies may, if they wish, designate areas where dogs' crates or boxes may be left in the vicinity of the rings.
- 30 No smoking or vaping is allowed within the ring area.
- 31 The handler must set their dog up to start within the ring. Dog and handler must enter the ring together and under no circumstances may a dog be left outside the ring off lead and recalled or sent to the handler in the ring.
- 32 Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
- 33 Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
- 34 Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.
- 35 It is the competitors responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club. In Championship classes competitors must run in exact running order specified in the regulations.
- 36 An exhibitor or competitor should ensure that contact details for any handler are available and must be provided upon request in any investigation of a breach of this regulation by such handler.
- 37 Animals in Event  
No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes, or by permission of the Board.  
However, at the discretion of the show society a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
- 38 A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
- 39 There will not be a practice ring. There will be a junior training ring for pre-entered structured training only.
- 40 Welfare of Dogs An exhibitor (or Competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licenced event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog is met, and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars or prong collars, is not permitted at an Agility show licensed by The Royal Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.
- 41 Competitors are reminded of the suffering that can be caused when dogs are left in vehicles on sunny days. Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs found in a distressed condition.
- 42 All dogs will be entered at this Show at their owner's risk. Whilst the Committee and helpers will undertake every care, they will not take responsibility for loss, damage or injury howsoever caused to dogs, persons or property.

- 43 There will be no practicing/training in the ring during or after the show.
- 44 The Competition Manager cannot enter or work a dog at the show
- 45 Please clear up after your dogs and place in bins provided. Anyone knowingly not doing so will be asked to leave the Venue and forfeit any remaining class entries.
- 46 Puppies under 12 weeks of age are not permitted at the Show. This includes the Car Parks and Exercise areas.
- 47 Please do not leave your dogs loose when unattended.
- 48 Speed limit on site is 5mph (KC recommendation) and will be strictly enforced. All drivers of vehicles on site must hold a full driving licence and be insured.
- 49 All caravans/camping units to carry suitable fire extinguishers and facilities for fire fighting and first aid. Camping pitches and electric hook up are not transferable and may not be purchased after close of entries. All units must display the official site pass on their unit denoting camping and or electric hook up at all times. Anyone found accessing camping and or electric hook up without the appropriate site pass will be removed from the Showground. Fire points will be indicated by a solid red flag. Campers are asked not to fly red flags from their caravans.
- 50 For the safety of dogs/people it is the responsibility of those using electric hook-ups and/or generators to provide adequate protection for cables and their own lead. People camping in groups who require electric will be sited nearest to the electric supply points.
- 51 All people and dogs attending the Show will be bound by Dogs In Need Rules. All Trade Stand vendors must comply with the Rules and Regulations of this Show. Only those having paid for a trade stand will be allowed to trade at this show, any un-authorised traders will be immediately removed from the showground forfeiting any camping/entry fees.
- 52 People or dogs acting in an unreasonable/irresponsible manner will be removed from the Show and forfeit all fees paid. All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult who will be held responsible for their conduct for the duration of the Show.
- 53 Definition of Test Area - all rings.
- 54 Running orders MUST be adhered to (with the exception of bona fide workers or a note from teacher) unless you want to face not running.
- 55 No camping units allowed on the Show ground before 9.00am Monday 12th August 2024. Early show helpers will be notified by a committee member and must book in on arrival. Camping numbers are limited. The Show ground will be locked from 23.00hrs - 07.00 hrs each night. Camping units will be received Monday 12th – Saturday 17th between the hours of 9.00am to 5.00pm only and all MUST vacate the showground by 3:00pm Sunday 18th August 2024.
- 56 Rosettes and awards must be collected at the Show. Rosettes & awards will not be issued before the official prize-giving.
- 57 The owner, competitor, handler or any other person in charge of a dog at a Kennel Club licensed event must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car & caravan parks & approaches. All dogs must be kept on lead other than when in the test area and the designated exercise area where they must still be under control.
- 58 All camping roadways on site must be kept clear at all times. The erection of training equipment is forbidden.
- 59 Day parkers must park in the day parking area only. Disabled people with badges will be allowed to park in the disabled parking area.
- 60 All people at this show have a responsibility to take care of the health and safety of themselves and others, and to report any health and safety concerns to the Show Manager
- 61 It is the responsibility of the handler to ensure that any change of handler is recorded with the Caller prior to competing.
- 62 The Committee reserves the right to cancel any entries.
- 63 Digital or analogue recording within the precincts of the show for reward or gain will only be allowed by permission of the Show Manager.
- 64 Under section 2 of the Health Act 2006, smoking will not be permitted within any covered or enclosed public area, including score tents.
- 65 Collecting of money is not permitted at this show.
- 66 The show organisers or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available (including but not limited to the names of competitors and their dogs) and share results with third parties for the same purpose.
- 67 Whistles might be used by judges at this event.
